While assisting in the investigation of the homicide of Kent Heitholt, I was assigned Lead #23 to speak with Columbia Tribune employee Michael Boyd. #260666 I contacted Boyd via telephone and he advised me of the following information.

Boyd advised me that he had left shortly after 0200 HRS on 11-01-01. He stated that the computers shut down at 0200 HRS, and that is why he left. He stated he talked to Mike the maintenance and/or cleaning crew personnel outside the door, and he said while outside the door the victim, Heitholt, came out a little bit after. Boyd stated that he saw Heitholt go to his car and he stated while standing there talking with Heitholt they began to talk about a ay cat that was there that was clawing at Heitholt's car tire. Boyd stated that he went to his vehicle, started to drive off and he saw Heitholt going into his vehicle head first and stated he did not know if he was getting in the rehicle to leave or just getting his bag in or out of the car. Boyd stated he lid not see anybody around the parking lot or anybody who was suspicious in nature:

I asked Boyd to be more specific about his time and he stated he left :he office at approximately 0200 HRS and talked to Mike the cleaning guy approximately five to ten minutes and then went to his car. He stated after peaking with Heitholt he probably left the Columbia Tribune at approximately 1220 HRS.

Boyd could not provide me with any further information, but was rovided with my phone number to contact me if any further information .eveloped.
